INTRODUCTION

In a context where droughts are becoming more extreme and efficient water management is becoming more crucial, the Region of Murcia is emerging as a talent hub where innovative solutions in this field are being developed. Meanwhile, **the European Union has launched several territorial cooperation programmes** that open calls for proposals to fund projects in efficient water management.

To address these challenges, **the Region of Murcia is organising a conference on 14 January 2025** with three main purposes:

1. Get to know these programmes, their calls for proposals and the opportunities they offer.

2. Give voice to those technicians, researchers and entities from the Region of Murcia that work in water management, so that they can share their competences and experience in these European projects.

3. Serve as a meeting platform for all those attending the meeting - in person or online - to exchange ideas and establish partnerships for the new call for green transition projects of the Interreg NEXT MED Programme and other European territorial cooperation programmes inside Interreg.

The conference is hybrid: *physically in Spanish and online in English* with simultaneous interpretation, the online version is exclusively aimed at registered participants from the different countries included in the Mediterranean area of the European programmes to be covered.
